- Update on finances and all approved
- Highlight of successes / CSP impact: Hip sprint, workforce planning, additional student places, pay rice, new CSP council & committees.

STUDENT PLACEMENTS - NETWORKING SESSION:

Overall there is an awareness that with student places increasing, so is the demand for placements; and a reminder that ALL of us have a place in training of the future workforce.

We need a culture change towards placements from students, educators and employers.

Models e.g. 2:1, Non clinical placements & not thinking of placements in silos.

INFLUENCING & LEADERSHIP KEY MESSAGES:

- -Be consistent in your pursuit
- -Keep patients at heart
- -Make your stories meaningful to who you are trying to influence
- -Find common ground with who you are trying to influence
- -You don't need permission to influence
- -We are all leaders, have the courage to do something
- -Often will need to influence multiple parts of the system to create change
- -The power of the patient story
- -Need to break down traditional views of roles -Roles should be about skills, tasks and competencies, not ring fenced professions.
- -We are all leaders



HIP SPRINT 'LOCAL' HUDDLE

Highlight that this is about auditing locally, as much as you can / want to, to make change at a local level.

- Many identified issues linking community / acute.
- Sign up to your local hip sprint huddle day on eventbrite!

SUPPORT WORKERS

- -Highlighting examples of good practice from around the country with highly skilled band 4 positions with use of good training / competency programmes and CPD.
- -Reminder that there are actually only a small list of things support workers cannot do:
- -Most likely group to have inadequate appraisals and training this must change!

We would love to hear about our south central support workers / associates / technicians / assistants!

-Support workers are not substitutes for registered staff but help release time of registered staff to other work.
